

## COOPENERGY Action Plan Report:

**Partner:** IRE SpA

**Joint-Action:** Joint procurement process and collaboration in Public Lighting in Liguria Region

**Pillar:** 1. Financial Instruments

**Regional/local authorities involved:** 45 Regional and Local Authorities involved in total, as signatories of the Regional Memorandum of Understanding. The related Steering Committee is composed by 12 representatives.

### About the joint action

Measures aimed to the refurbishment of the Public Lighting system are a priority in almost all Municipalities of Liguria committed to the Covenant of Mayors and this represents, indeed, a key action in all the local SEAPs since, despite its contribution target in terms of CO<sub>2</sub> is not comparable to other actions, its impact is considerable in terms of raising awareness the citizens about energy efficiency issues and potentials. In order to meet the needs of the Local Authorities it was decided to focus on this topic for the JAs regional activities supported by IRE within COOPENERGY.

### About the Collaboration model

The involvement of **Regional and Local Authorities** for this JA activities is committed to the establishment of a dedicated Local Working Group whose goal is the successful implementation of the JA. In Liguria, the LWGs meetings were connected to the Regional **Steering Committee** of the **Memorandum of Understanding for the Covenant of Mayors** The SC met to discuss the regional energy policies (aimed also to Regional SEAP review) and the concrete actions linked to the JA activities.

3 meetings took place so far, in February, April and June 2015. Other meetings are planned for the fall 2015 since it was established as a permanent regional tool.

In order to support the Municipalities in the process of public lighting refurbishment providing concrete tools, IRE SpA worked to collect the related existing good practices in the Region and to share in the working tables all these resources As final step, **a draft of a model of a joint procurement tender** for the public lighting renovation will be provided by IRE SpA to support all the municipalities that are interested in carry on these activities
